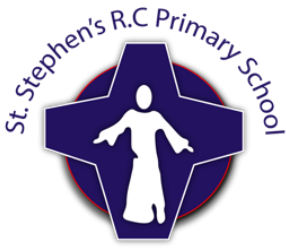
We also say goodbye to Mr Meleady, Miss Abbey, and Mrs Khan — thank you for your contributions and we wish you all every success in your next chapter.
